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## COUNTRYSIDE CHRISTIAN CHURCH YOUTH GROUP BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

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1. When transportation is involved in any youth activity, all students ride the church bus or van(s). No student is allowed to drive, unless they have written permission from their parents taking full responsibility for their driving.
2. Students are expected to comply with any and all instructions given by adult youth staff members.
3. Students are to demonstrate respect for the Lord by demonstrating respect for church facilities and vehicles. Should a student's actions cause damage or breakage, he/she will be held responsible for repair or replacement of the broken or damaged item.
4. When attending church activities, all students are expected to participate in those activities: not hang around outside, roam the hallways, etc.
5. When participating in church activities, all students are expected to be present for the entirety of any event. Unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time between the youth minister and a student's parents, no student is allowed to arrive at an event late or to leave early.
6. When we return from an activity, parents are to pick up their students at the time stated. Because we try very hard both to accurately pinpoint our return time and to notify parents from the road on those rare occasions when we do experience major delays, we ask that parents be here to meet us when we arrive, rather than waiting at home for a phone call from their young person.
7. Upon our return from any road trip, students are expected to help clean the vehicle(s) before claiming their luggage and going home. The trailer will remain locked until the vehicle(s) pass inspection.
8. In the interest of maintaining a positive, Christ-centered atmosphere at all youth functions, we ask that students keep modesty in mind in their clothing choices. Guys are to wear shirts at all times (except when swimming). Gals should avoid extremely short skirts, low necklines, and other revealing clothing, and wear only modest one-piece swimwear. In addition, clothing worn to youth events should be free of ungodly images and messages.
9. Unless otherwise noted, portable entertainment devices such as Walkmans, Discmans, Watchmans, Gameboys, etc., are not to be brought to youth events or on youth trips. On those occasions when such gizmos are permitted, students are to exercise the utmost discernment in the music they choose to bring. Our youth leaders reserve the right to permanently confiscate tapes or CDs which blatantly promote ungodliness. Call Alex Gilpin if you have any questions.
10. Promotion takes place the first Sunday in June, at which time all promoted students are expected to begin attending their new group. The only exception to this policy are high school graduates, who may continue to participate in high school activities through the end middle of August.
11. This should go without saying, but for the record, alcohol, tobacco of any kind, illegal drugs, firearms, knives, foul language, public displays of affection which venture beyond hand-holding, uncooperative attitudes, and derogatory remarks to or about the youth staff will not be permitted to be a part of any Countryside youth function.

The youth staff of Countryside Christian Church reserves the right to dismiss or suspend from any youth activity any young person who demonstrates an attitude of indifference to God and to others by willfully and remorselessly violating these guidelines. *If the violation occurs during the course of an out-of-town event, dismissal may include sending the student home at his/her parents' expense.*
